As the seat of the Parliament and the Senate, the City Hall is the political centre of our city. All sittings of the Parliament are open to the public. How the Assembly sittings are organised

The Plenary Assembly meets every second Wednesday, except during recesses, starting at 1.30 p.m. and usually lasting into the evening. The day's business is set out on the order paper.

The Assembly sittings are chaired by the President or one of the Vice-Presidents and start with a debate on issues of current political interest. Four Parliamentary Groups can register topics for this in rotating order.

After that, the individual items on the order paper are called for discussion, debate and a vote. Elections also take place during the sittings.

The calendar of sittings of the Hamburg Parliament for the whole of the year, giving dates of plenary and committee sittings, is shown on notice boards in the City Hall lobby and on the parliamentary website (hamburgische-buergerschaft.de).

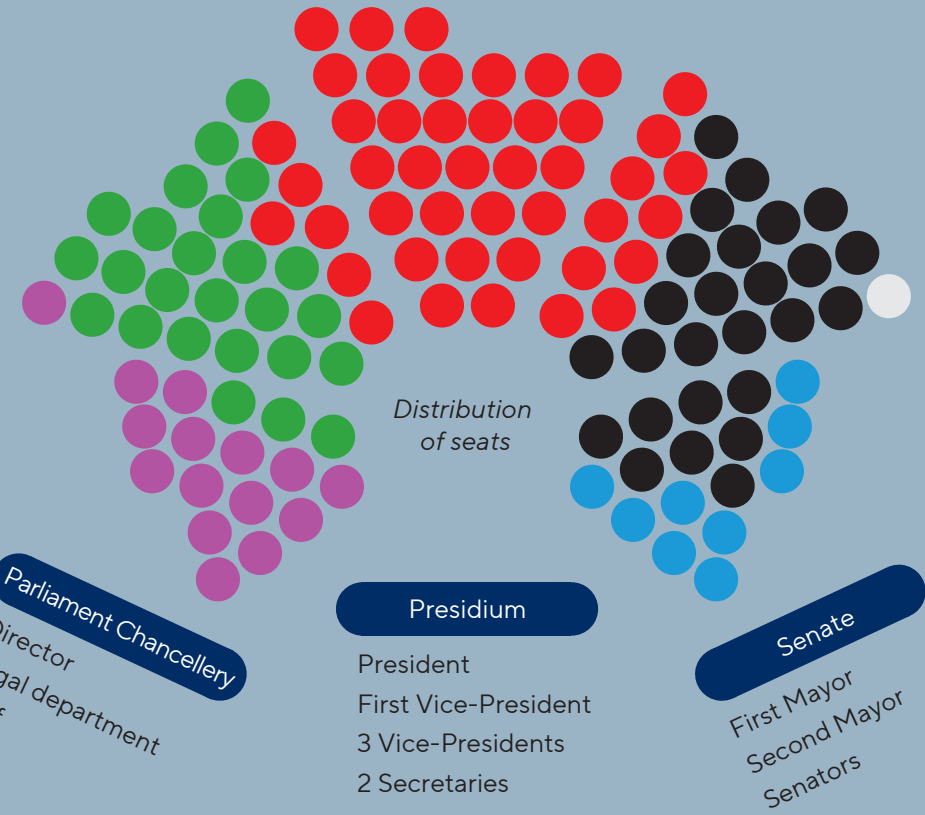
